The aforementioned units are prohibited from undertaking any activity pertaining to handling of Hazardous and other Wastes within the state of Assam or anywhere in the country.

All occupiers under the purview of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 are hereby directed not to hand over their hazardous and other waste to these units henceforth.
