Applications are invited from eligible Indian citizens for engagement of one (01) **Junior Research Fellow (JRF)** on a purely contractual basis for implementation and monitoring of the “Carbon Sequestration Plantation Project” being implemented by the **Assam Pollution Control Board (APCB)** under the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **Indian Oil Corporation Limited (Assam Oil Division), Digboi Refinery, Digboi, Dist:Tinsukia, Assam.**

The engagement is project-specific and co-terminus with the project.

- 1. Name of the Post** : Junior Research Fellow (JRF)
- 2. Number of Posts** : 01 (One)
- 3. Place of Posting** : Project sites located in Tinsukia District, Assam.
- 4. Duration of Engagement** : The engagement shall be purely contractual for a period of two (02) years or till completion of the project, whichever is earlier. The engagement shall not confer any claim for regular appointment under APCB.
- 5. Essential Educational Qualification** : Candidates must possess:

Master's Degree in Forestry/Environmental Science/Botany/Agriculture/Ecology/Life Sciences or any other relevant discipline from a recognized University with at least 55% marks (or equivalent CGPA).

6. Desirable Qualifications : Preference will be given to candidates having experience in one or more of the following:

- Forestry and plantation monitoring.
- Carbon sequestration or climate change projects.
- GIS and Remote Sensing applications.
- GPS/RTK GPS survey and geo-referencing.
- Drone-based mapping and aerial documentation.
- Environmental monitoring and field surveys.
- Preparation of technical reports and scientific documentation.
- Data analysis and management.

7. Age Limit : As per Government/APCB norms applicable on the last date of submission of applications.

8. Monthly Remuneration : Rs. 40,000/- plus HRA

9. Duties and Responsibilities : The selected JRF shall be responsible for, inter alia:

- Conducting baseline surveys of plantation sites.
- Geo-referencing, GPS and RTK GPS-based mapping of plantation areas.
- GIS database preparation and spatial analysis.

B. Technical Competency

The candidate shall possess, or demonstrate willingness and ability to acquire, operational proficiency in the following equipment and software required for project implementation:

- Drone operation for survey and documentation
- GIS-enabled field data collection
- QGIS or ArcGIS Online
- Geo-tagged field data collection platforms
- Soil testing kits
- Soil moisture meters
- Chlorophyll meters
- Densitometers
- Other environmental monitoring instruments as required

Candidates having prior experience in operating any of the above equipment/software shall be given due preference during selection.

- Performance in the written test and/or interview, as may be decided by APCB.
